Glossary of terms

Access:

- Patient is able to receive the dental care they need.

Accessible:

- All patients, no matter their abilities, can understand and use the services.

Comprehensive dental care:

- Dentist or dental office that offers all dental services.

Emergency dental care:

- Any injury to your mouth that causes uncontrolled bleeding, severe pain, or broken facial bones.

Federal Poverty Line:

- Measure of income used to determine eligibility for low-income programs and benefits. To learn more, visit the link below.

General anesthesia:

- Process of putting a patient to sleep to receive dental services.

Medically underserved:

- People who have limited access to health care services and often face barriers to getting care.

Patients with special health care needs:

- Any physical, developmental, mental, sensory, behavioral, cognitive, or emotional impairment or limiting condition that requires medical management, health care intervention, and/or use of specialized services or programs.

Preventive dental care:

- Proper care of teeth and gums to maintain oral health. Services can include brushing, flossing, dental check-ups, and regular dental cleanings.

Restorative dental care:

- Any dental service that replaces or repairs a tooth. Services can include fillings, root canals, crowns, bridges, partial dentures, and full dentures.

Sliding fee scale:

- An agreement between a provider and a client to pay a reduced rate for dental services.

Sustainable:

- Able to be cared for by the patient after services have been completed.
