

The Health Care Workforce Financial Assistance Program provides educational loan repayment assistance to healthcare professionals who locate and practice in underserved areas in the state of Utah. The provider's site is required to match 20% of the award amount. This is a 3-year service commitment to the State of Utah. Participating sites are required to be located inside of a <u>Health Professional</u> <u>Shortage Area (HPSA).</u>

Who qualifies & how much is the award?*

MD/DO/DDS/PHARM \$75,000 PSYCH/PA/APRN/CNM \$45,000 LMFT/LCSW \$37,500 BS/BA RN/RDH, BSDH \$30,000 AA RN/SUDC/RDH, AAS \$15,000 CPSS \$750

What are the requirements?

Once accepted into the program, you must continue to work at the site for 3 years and submit semiannual progress reports to our office.

*This is the total award amount over the entire contract period.

What makes you eligible?

- You meet the direct patient care requirement (no more than 8 hours spent on administrative activities for full time awards; 4 hours for part time awards).
- You work at least 20 hours for a part time award.
- You work at an approved job site.
- You have an unrestricted license that does not require supervision.
- You have worked at your site for fewer than 18 months.
